SUPREME COURT Narrative Summary

During fiscal year 2000, there were 1,402 cases filed in the Supreme Court, an increase of 6.3% in total filings from the 1,319 cases filed in FY 1999. The categories with the largest percentage increases were Criminal Appeals, which increased 50.0% from 6 in FY 1999 to 9 in FY 2000, and Criminal Petitions for Review (48.0%), which went from 450 in FY 1999 to 666 in FY 2000. Numerically, Criminal Petitions for Review case filings also showed the greatest increase (+216). The categories with the largest percentage decrease were Special Action (-51.6%) and Juvenile Petitions for Review (-32.4%). Civil Petitions for Review showed the largest numerical decline, from 401 in FY 1999 to 359 in FY 2000. In general, most case filing categories declined from FY 1999 levels as 10 of the 14 categories showed declines between 10% and 51%.

In the same period, the Supreme Court disposed of 1,281 cases, a decrease of 8.5% from the 1,400 cases disposed during the previous fiscal year.

The differences between filings and terminations resulted in a pending caseload increase by 17.6%, from 493 cases on July 1, 1999 to 580 cases on June 30, 2000.

Detailed breakdowns of "State Bar Matters" and "All Other Cases" and a State Bar Activity Report follow the filings and terminations summaries.

Some of the FY 1999 figures may not correspond to figures published in last year's Data Report due to corrected information received subsequent to publication of the Report.



COURT OF APPEALS - DIVISION ONE Narrative Summary

Division One of the Court of Appeals experienced a decline in case filings in fiscal year 2000. Total filings decreased by 8.1%, from 2,672 in FY 1999 to 2,455. Civil and Criminal categories showed the greatest numerical decrease in filings, declining by 123 (or 17.6%) and 71 or (9.0%) respectively from the previous fiscal year.

In contrast to filings, total case dispositions showed an increase, from 2,457 in FY 1999 to 2,826 in FY 2000, an increase of 15.0%.

The total pending caseload figure decreased from 2,274 on July 1, 1999 to 1,918 on June 30, 2000, a decline of 15.7%.

A new mental health case filing category was added this year, called Mental Health Sexual Predator. This category tracks the division-reported number of sexual predator cases filed. Currently, Division One does not break out sexual predator cases from the mental health case category, while Division Two began reporting sexual predator cases separately from mental health cases for FY 2000



COURT OF APPEALS - DIVISION TWO Narrative Summary

Following the overall trend in the appellate courts, Division Two of the Court of Appeals experienced a decline in case filings. In fiscal year 2000, total filings decreased by 5.5%, from 1,120 in FY 1999 to 1,058. The most notable declines were in Civil, Criminal and Habeas Corpus filings which decreased by 6.7%, 18.7% and 150.0% respectively from the previous fiscal year.

Dispositions showed an increase of 14.4%, from 1,146 in FY 1999 to 1,311 in FY 2000. Most of the increase was in the "Criminal" and "Post Conviction Relief" categories.

The total pending caseload figure decreased from 1,265 on July 1, 1999 to 1,101 on June 30, 2000, this is a decrease of 13.0%.

A new mental health case filing category was added this year, called Mental Health Sexual Predator. This category tracks the division-reported number of sexual predator cases filed. Currently, Division One does not break out sexual predator cases from the mental health case category, while Division Two began reporting sexual predator cases separately from mental health cases for FY 2000


