

CONSENT TO DISBARMENT

Respondent.

I, **Christopher R. Perry**, whose address of record is 7000 N. 16th St., Ste. 120, Phoenix, AZ 85020-5506, voluntarily consent to disbarment as a member of the State Bar of Arizona and consent to the removal of my name from the roster of those permitted to practice before this court, and from the roster of the State Bar of Arizona. By stipulation with the State Bar of Arizona, I previously consented to interim suspension on March 10, 2011, and the Presiding Disciplinary Judge ("PDJ") entered an Order of Interim Suspension on March 11, 2011. The PDJ issued an Order of Stay on March 11, 2011. On March 18, 2011, the PDJ issued an Order Re: Partial and Temporary Relief from Interim Suspension. On March 29, 2011, I filed a Notice of Rule 72(e) Compliance. The PDJ lifted the Stay on December 13, 2012.

I acknowledge that charges have been made against me. I have read the charges, and the charges there made against me. I further acknowledge that I do

not desire to contest or defend the charges, but wish to consent to disbarment. I have been advised of and have had an opportunity to exercise my right to be represented in this matter by a lawyer. I consent to disbarment freely and voluntarily and not under coercion or intimidation. I am aware of the rules of the Supreme Court with respect to discipline, disability, resignation and reinstatement, and I understand that any future application by me for admission or reinstatement as a member of the State Bar of Arizona will be treated as an application by a member who has been disbarred for professional misconduct, as set forth in the charges made against me. The misconduct of which I am accused is described in the document attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Pursuant to Rule 60(b), Ariz.R.Sup.Ct., I am responsible for the costs and expenses of these disciplinary proceedings. The State Bar's statement of costs and expenses is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

A proposed form of judgment of disbarment is attached hereto as Exhibit C.

AMENDED JUDGMENT OF **DISBARMENT**

Pursuant to Rule 57, Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., the undersigned Presiding Disciplinary Judge of the Supreme Court of Arizona has considered the parties Stipulated Motion to Amend the Judgment of Disbarment filed on March 26, 2013, to reflect a retroactive effective date of disbarment of March 11, 2011. Accordingly:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED accepting the consent to disbarment. Respondent, Christopher R. Perry, is hereby disbarred from the State Bar of Arizona and his name is hereby stricken from the roll of lawyers effective retroactively on March 11, 2011, the date the Order of Interim Suspension was entered.

Respondent is no longer entitled to the rights and privileges of a lawyer but remains subject to the jurisdiction of the court. Respondent shall immediately comply with the requirements relating to notification of clients and others, and provide and/or file all notices and affidavits required by Rule 72, Ariz. R. Sup. Ct.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that no further disciplinary action shall be taken in reference to the matters that are the subject of the charges upon which the consent to disbarment and this judgment of disbarment are based.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent pay the costs and expenses of the State Bar of Arizona in the amount of \$1,210.20.
