SUPREME COURT Narrative Summary

During fiscal year 2005, there were 1,164 cases filed in the Supreme Court, a decrease of 0.5% in total filings from the 1,170 cases filed in FY 2004. The categories with the largest percentage decreases were Post Conviction Relief cases, which decreased 64.3% from 14 in FY 2004 to 5 in FY 2005, and Rule 28 Petitions (-33.3%), which went from 42 in FY 2004 to 28 in FY 2005. Numerically, Civil Petitions for Review case filings showed the greatest decrease (-27) and accounted for a drop of 7.5%. The category with the largest percentage increase was Habeas Corpus cases (+50.0%).

In the same period, the Supreme Court disposed of 1,122 cases, a decrease of 7.3% from the 1,210 cases disposed during the previous fiscal year.

The differences between filings and terminations resulted in a pending caseload increase of 12.3%, from 367 cases on July 1, 2004 to 412 cases on June 30, 2005.

Detailed breakdowns of "State Bar Matters" and "All Other Cases" and a State Bar Activity Report follow the filings and terminations summaries.



COURT OF APPEALS - DIVISION ONE Narrative Summary

Division One of the Court of Appeals experienced an increase in case filings in fiscal year 2005. Total filings increased by 14.4%, from 2,596 in FY 2004 to 2,970 in FY 2005. Both Post Conviction Relief and Unemployment Board case categories showed the greatest numerical increase in filings, increasing by 385 (104.6%) and 31 (23.5%) respectively, from the previous fiscal year. Criminal case filings experienced the largest numerical decrease (48 or 8.0%), followed by Juvenile cases (17 or 7.8%). Industrial Commission case filings increased by 11.0%, from 127 in FY 2004 to 141 in FY 2005.

Total case dispositions showed a decrease, from 2,684 in FY 2004 to 2,630 in FY 2004, a decrease of 2.0%.

The total pending caseload figure increased from 2,114 on July 1, 2004 to 2,502 on June 30, 2005, an increase of 18.4%.

A new mental health case filing category was added in fiscal year 2000, called Mental Health (MH) Sexual Predator. This category tracks the division-reported number of sexual predator cases filed. Division One began breaking out sexual predator cases from the mental health case category in fiscal year 2003, while Division Two began reporting sexual predator cases separately from mental health cases in fiscal year 2000.



COURT OF APPEALS - DIVISION TWO Narrative Summary

Division Two of the Court of Appeals experienced an increase in case filings. In fiscal year 2005, total filings increased by 4.7%, from 861 in FY 2004 to 901. The most notable increase was in Post Conviction Relief filings which increased by 33.6%, from 131 filings in FY 2004 to 175 in FY 2005. The other category that shows a significant increase in filings was the Civil case category which increased from 141 in FY 2004 to 173 in FY 2005, or 22.7%. Juvenile case filings decreased from the previous fiscal year by 19.1%, from 115 in FY 2004 to 93 in FY 2005.

Dispositions showed a large increase of 45.0%, from 840 in FY 2004 to 1,218 in FY 2005. Most of the increase was in the "Criminal" and "Post Conviction Relief" categories.

The total pending caseload figure decreased from 1,243 on July 1, 2004 to 954 on June 30, 2005. This is a decrease of 23.3%.

A new mental health case filing category was added in fiscal year 2000, called Mental Health (MH) Sexual Predator. This category tracks the division-reported number of sexual predator cases filed. Division One began breaking out sexual predator cases from the mental health case category in fiscal year 2003, while Division Two began reporting sexual predator cases separately from mental health cases in fiscal year 2000.


