SUPREME COURT Narrative Summary

During fiscal year 2001, there were 1,248 cases filed in the Supreme Court, a decrease of 11.0% in total filings from the 1,402 cases filed in FY 2000. The categories with the largest percentage decreases were Habeas Corpus cases, which decreased 64.2% from 81 in FY 2000 to 29 in FY 2001, and Rule 28 Petitions (-36.6%), which went from 30 in FY 2000 to 19 in FY 2001. Numerically, Criminal Petitions for Review case filings showed the greatest decrease (-178) and accounted for a drop of 26.7%. The categories with the largest percentage increase was State Bar Matters (+124.4%). In general, most case filing categories declined from FY 2000 levels as 11 of the 14 categories showed declines between 8.7% and 64.2%.

In the same period, the Supreme Court disposed of 1,357 cases, an increase of 5.9% from the 1,281 cases disposed during the previous fiscal year.

The differences between filings and terminations resulted in a pending caseload decrease of 21.7%, from 580 cases on July 1, 2000 to 454 cases on June 30, 2001.

Detailed breakdowns of "State Bar Matters" and "All Other Cases" and a State Bar Activity Report follow the filings and terminations summaries.



COURT OF APPEALS - DIVISION ONE Narrative Summary

Division One of the Court of Appeals experienced a decrease in case filings in fiscal year 2001. Total filings decreased by 1.7%, from 2,455 in FY 2000 to 2,414. The Special Actions category showed the greatest numerical decrease in filings, declining by 83 (or 24.7%) from the previous fiscal year. Both Criminal and Civil case filings increased in FY 2001. Criminal case filings rose 5.9%, from 716 in FY 2000 to 758 in FY 2001. Civil case filings rose slightly, from 576 in FY 2000 to 582 in FY 2001, and increase of 1.1%.

Total case dispositions showed a decrease, from 2,826 in FY 2000 to 2,522 in FY 2001, a decrease of 10.8%.

The total pending caseload figure decreased from 1,918 on July 1, 2000 to 1,823 on June 30, 2001, a decline of 5.0%.

A new mental health case filing category was added in FY 2000, called Mental Health Sexual Predator. This category tracks the division-reported number of sexual predator cases filed. Division One began breaking out sexual predator cases from the mental health case category this fiscal year, while Division Two began reporting sexual predator cases separately from mental health cases in FY 2000.



COURT OF APPEALS - DIVISION TWO Narrative Summary

Following the overall trend in the appellate courts, Division Two of the Court of Appeals experienced a decline in case filings. In fiscal year 2001, total filings decreased by 1.0%, from 1,058 in FY 2000 to 1,048. The most notable decline was in Special Action filings which decreased by 20.3% from the previous fiscal year. Criminal, Civil and Habeas Corpus case filings increased from the previous fiscal year by 0.9%, 4.5% and 310.0% respectively.

Dispositions showed a decrease of 10.6%, from 1,311 in FY 2000 to 1,172 in FY 2001. Most of the decrease was in the "Criminal" and "Post Conviction Relief" categories.

The total pending caseload figure decreased from 1,101 on July 1, 2000 to 1,041 on June 30, 2001. This is a decrease of 5.5%.

A new mental health case filing category was added in FY 2000, called Mental Health (MH) Sexual Predator. This category tracks the division-reported number of sexual predator cases filed. Division One began breaking out sexual predator cases from the mental health case category this fiscal year, while Division Two began reporting sexual predator cases separately from mental health cases in FY 2000.


