ANNUAL CASE ACTIVITY Narrative Summary

Total filings (including transfers in) decreased by 1.2% in FY 2004, from 2,529,361 in FY 2003 to 2,498,756 in FY 2004.

Criminal filings decreased from 437,431 in FY 2003 to 435,212 in FY 2004, a decrease of .5%. Civil filings increased 6.9%, from 288,307 in FY 2003 to 308,064 in FY 2004. Traffic filings (applicable only in justice and municipal courts) decreased by 2.9%, from 1,613,092 last year to 1,566,407 in FY 2004.

Total dispositions (including transfers out) increased by 1.3% from 2,469,011 in FY 2003 to 2,499,906 in FY 2004.

Orders of protection petitions rose 1.2%, from 31,510 in FY 2003 to 31,875 in FY 2004. Emergency orders of protection were down by 34.4%, from 157 last year to 103 in FY 2004. Injunctions against harassment petitions increased .7%, from 21,566 in FY 2003 to 21,714 in FY 2004.

The total number of trials held in the Arizona courts increased in FY 2004 by 33.8% from 53,151 last year to 71,057 in FY 2004. The vast majority were court trials in limited jurisdiction courts. These figures may not be comparable to FY 2003 because Maricopa Justice Administration has trained court staff to count all appearances with a judge relating to forcible detainer cases as a court trial.

Adults on probation (active standard and intensive) as of June 30, 2004 increased by 3.8%, from 35,471 in FY 2003 to 36,803 in FY 2004. Juveniles on probation experienced a 2.7% increase, from 8,876 in FY 2003 to 9,115 in FY 2004.

There were 1,275 cases filed (including 22 reopened cases) in the Arizona Tax Court during FY 2004, representing a 21.1% increase from the 1,053 cases filed in FY 2003. Arizona Tax Court filings are reported in Superior Court "other" category in the statewide totals.

Some of the FY 2003 figures may not correspond to figures published in last year's Data Report due to corrected information received subsequent to publication of the Report. Statistical reports received from courts are checked for mathematical accuracy, but are not audited by the Supreme Court.

COURT REVENUEStatewide Narrative Summary

The statewide revenue data is provided here for each level of the Arizona courts. The first table shows the source and distribution of revenues collected by courts. The figures were compiled from probation fee reports and the quarterly revenue surveys distributed by the Supreme Court for FY 2004. Major revenue categories shown represent monies collected from four sources:

FINES, SANCTIONS, FORFEITURES: Revenue from monetary penalties assessed in criminal, traffic, and juvenile matters, and bond monies that were forfeited;

SURCHARGES: Revenue from monetary assessments authorized by statute above and beyond criminal and traffic penalties and certain civil and other fees:

FEES: Revenue from collectible fees for services of the court and chargeable aspects of case processing;

OTHER REVENUE: Revenue from sources not otherwise specified.

Total revenue collected by the Arizona courts increased from \$229,757,324 in FY 2003 to \$252,214,846 in FY 2004, an increase of 9.8%.

The first table shows that the fees category accounts for \$97,968,984, or 38.8% of the total. Fines make up the second largest segment of court revenue, totaling \$90,025,062, or 35.7%. The third largest revenue category is surcharges, with \$62,984,620, or 25.0% of the total revenue.

The second table shows that FY2004 court revenue, as in previous years, is distributed fairly evenly among the state, counties, and municipalities (30.0%-36.2%), and that Municipal Courts generate almost half of all court revenue (\$120,449,260, or 47.8%). The third table (on the same page) shows that the Arizona courts processed \$104,177,253 in "pass-through" trust monies, of which restitution accounted for \$16,069,730 of the total. The majority collected was in "bail bonds", which represents 49.8% of the total.

The establishment of a central support payment clearinghouse to receive, disburse and monitor support payments pursuant to title IV-D of the Social Security Act, which started to take effect in FY 1998, has moved all child support payments from the courts to the Department of Economic Security. The courts only collected \$217,317 in FY 2004.

COURT EXPENDITURES Statewide Narrative Summary

The statewide expenditure information is provided here for each level of the Arizona courts. The first table shows court expenditures by source, fund, or other category. These data were compiled from Supreme Court financial records, program fund revertment reports, and annual expenditure surveys submitted to the Supreme Court for FY 2004. Major expenditure categories shown represent monies expended from five sources:

PRIMARY BUDGET: Expenditures of appropriated funds from the court's primary funding source, either the state (Supreme Court and Court of Appeals), the county (Superior and Justice Courts), or the city or town (Municipal Courts)--categories are kept as general as possible because line-item definitions for the state, counties, and municipalities vary widely;

STATE FUNDS: Expenditures of state program monies begun or renewed by the Arizona legislature and distributed to the courts;

FEDERAL FUNDS: Expenditures of federal program monies begun or renewed by the U.S. Congress and distributed to the courts (often via state agencies);

LOCAL FUNDS: Examples are expenditures from collections authorized by statute to reimburse all or part of the expenses of probation, automation, and other court services;

PRIVATE FUNDS: Expenditures of additional grants from other sources.

Total expenditures in the Arizona courts increased from \$508,165,006 to \$516,477,615 in FY 2004, up 1.6%. Primary budget expenditures account for 73.6% of the total. Salary and fringe benefit expenditures account for the largest portion (82.3%) of the primary budget. Outside primary budget expenditures, state funds account for the next largest group, at 20.1%.

The second table shows, as in previous years, that Arizona counties contributed almost half of the funds to operate the state's courts this year (\$314,267,573, or 60.9%). Likewise, the state again contributed approximately one-fourth of courts' expenditures in FY 2004 (\$120,950,916, or 23.4%). Expenditures from three out of five sources increased from FY 2003, and again, over two-thirds of these expenses were at the Superior Court level (\$364,326,246, or 70.5%).
