In the Matter of Osmond Burton, Bar No. 001162, PDJ-2012-2025. Attorney Reprimand, Two years of Probation, Payment of Restitution and Costs imposed.

Pursuant to Rule 57(a), Ariz.R.Sup.Ct., the presiding disciplinary judge accepted an agreement for discipline by consent submitted by the parties and reprimanded Respondent Osmond Burton effective April 6, 2012.

While representing a client in a family law matter, Respondent lost documents, failed to timely file documents, failed to timely respond to communications made by his client, and failed to timely respond to the State Bar's investigation. As a result of Respondent's failures, his client was sanctioned in the amount of \$1,215.

Aggravating factors: Prior disciplinary history, a pattern of misconduct and substantial experience in the practice of law.

Mitigating factor: Remorse

Respondent violated Rule 42, Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., specifically ERs 1.3, 1.4, 1.5, 1.15, and 8.4(d), and Rule 54(d)(2), Ariz. R. Sup. Ct.

The agreement is accepted and costs awarded in the amount of \$1,200.00. The proposed final judgment and order is reviewed, approved and signed.
