

## **COURT REVENUE**

### **Limited Jurisdiction Courts Narrative Summary**

The revenue data provided here are for the Limited Jurisdiction Courts of Arizona. The figures were compiled from quarterly revenue surveys submitted to the Supreme Court during fiscal year 2000. Major revenue categories shown represent monies collected from four sources:

**FINES, SANCTIONS, FORFEITURES:** Revenue from monetary penalties assessed in criminal, traffic, and juvenile matters, and bond monies that were forfeited;

**SURCHARGES:** Revenue from monetary assessments authorized by statute above and beyond criminal and traffic penalties and certain civil and other fees;

**FEES:** Revenue from collectible fees for services of the court and chargeable aspects of case processing;

**OTHER REVENUE:** Revenue from sources not otherwise specified.

Total revenue collected by Limited Jurisdiction Courts increased from \$130,878,430 in FY 1999 to \$136,722,069 in FY 2000, an increase of 4.5%. Justice Court revenue increased from \$44,483,900 last year to \$49,641,897 in FY 2000, up 11.6%. Municipal Court revenue went from \$86,394,530 in FY 1999 to \$87,080,172 in FY 2000, an increase of .8%.

The fines category is the largest at \$66,804,832, accounting for 48.9% of the total. Most of these fines (\$43,118,655, or 64.5%) were assessed in Municipal Courts. The second largest category is surcharges, accounting for \$42,262,761, or 30.9% of the total revenue. Again, the majority of the surcharges were assessed in Municipal Courts (\$26,751,624, or 63.3%).

Maricopa and Pima County Justice Courts comprise 54.8% of all Justice Court revenue. Municipal Courts from these two counties constitute 84.4% of all Municipal Court revenue. The two largest Municipal Courts --Phoenix and Tucson--not only account for 39.5% of all Municipal Court revenue, but 25.1% of the revenue from all Arizona Limited Jurisdiction Courts. In all, Maricopa and Pima County Limited Jurisdiction Courts collect 73.7% of all Justice and Municipal Court revenue.

The Annual Trust Money Collection Summary shows that the Limited Jurisdiction Courts processed \$26,766,714 in "pass-through" trust monies in FY 2000, most of which (91.7%) were for bail bonds.

## **COURT EXPENDITURE**

### **Limited Jurisdiction Courts Narrative Summary**

The expenditure information provided here is for each Justice of the Peace and Municipal Court in Arizona. These data were compiled from program fund reversion reports and annual expenditure surveys submitted to the Supreme Court for FY 2000. Major expenditure categories shown represent monies expended from five sources:

**PRIMARY BUDGET:** Expenditures of appropriated funds from the court's primary funding source, either the county (Justice Courts) or the city or town (Municipal Courts)--categories are kept as general as possible because line-item definitions for the counties and municipalities vary widely;

**STATE FUNDS:** Expenditures of state program monies begun or renewed by the Arizona legislature and distributed to the courts;

**FEDERAL FUNDS:** Expenditures of federal program monies begun or renewed by the U.S. Congress and distributed to the courts (often via state agencies);

**PRIVATE FUNDS:** Expenditures of additional grants from other sources;

**LOCAL FUNDS:** Examples are expenditures from collections authorized by statute or local ordinance to reimburse all or part of the expenses of court services.

Total expenditures in all Limited Jurisdiction Courts increased from \$89,868,276 to \$99,968,518 in FY 2000, an increase of 11.2%. Primary budget expenses (city and county) account for 93.5% of the total. Justice Courts experienced an increase of 17.5% in total expenditures, from \$28,570,733 last year to \$33,574,276 in FY 2000. The Municipal Courts had a 8.3% increase in total expenditures for FY 2000, from \$61,297,543 in FY 1999 to \$66,394,242.

Maricopa and Pima county Justice Courts make up 62.4% of the statewide Justice Court expenditures, and Municipal Courts from these two large counties constitute 88.2% of statewide Municipal Court expenditures. Phoenix and Tucson Municipal Courts alone comprise 59.0% of all Municipal Court expenditures, and 39.2% of the expenditures of all Limited Jurisdiction Courts in Arizona. In all, Maricopa and Pima county Limited Jurisdiction Courts account for 79.5% of all Justice and Municipal Court expenditures.

**COURT PERSONNEL**  
**Limited Jurisdiction Courts Narrative Summary**

The limited jurisdiction summary illustrates all court positions in Justice of the Peace and Municipal Courts as of June 30, 2000, including positions funded from both primary and non-primary budget sources. The information was reported by the individual courts in response to the Supreme Court personnel survey mailed in July 2000.

The total number of persons working full-time in the Limited Jurisdiction Courts increased 4.3%, from 1,551 in FY 1999 to 1,618 in FY 2000. In FY 2000 there were 634 people employed full-time in the Justice Courts, up from 626 the previous year. The Municipal Courts' full-time employees increased from 925 last fiscal year to 984 in FY 2000.

The Limited Jurisdiction Courts employed an additional 408 part-time personnel in FY 2000, compared to 361 in FY 1999, an increase of 13.0%. The Justice Courts employed 131 part-time personnel, compared to 95 in FY 1999. The Municipal Courts employed 277 part-time personnel, compared to 266 in FY 1999.

The courts also had the services of 58 regular volunteers in FY 2000. Volunteers include non-professionals and professionals who serve in various capacities, from support staff to on-call magistrates. The Justice Courts utilized 43 regular volunteers while the Municipal Courts had the services of 15.

Additionally, the Limited Jurisdiction Courts utilized 23,252 hours of temporary personnel assistance in FY 2000. The Justice Courts used 5,887 hours of temporary personnel, while the Municipal Courts had 17,365 hours.
