- Extend or change appeal deadlines. Appeals must be filed within 30 days after the
 decision you are challenging was made and entered by the Court. The Court of Appeals
 also sets deadlines for filing briefs that you must follow.

THIS PROGRAM ONLY APPLIES TO:

 Family and general civil cases decided by the Superior Court in Maricopa County.

- Cases that are on appeal to the Court of Appeals. An appeal happens after the trial court has made its final decision and entered a signed order; it is an opportunity for you to ask the Court of Appeals to review that decision to determine if it was legally correct based on the evidence you have already presented.
