IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that **JOHN T. FRANKLIN**, a suspended member of the State Bar of Arizona, is hereby disbarred from the practice of law, effective from the date of this judgment and order, for conduct in violation of his duties and obligations as a lawyer, as disclosed in the Disciplinary Commission Report.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **JOHN T. FRANKLIN** shall pay restitution in the following amounts to the following individuals:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent shall comply with all rule provisions regarding reinstatement proceedings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent shall be assessed costs and expenses of the disciplinary proceedings as provided in Rule 60(b).
