Judiciary Mourns Death of Retired Superior Court in Pima County Judge Harry Gin



The state judiciary mourns the death of retired Superior Court in Pima County Judge Harry Gin who died last week. He was 84.

Retired Judge Gin was born in 1927 in Tucson, AZ. He received his bachelor's degree from the University of Arizona and received his LL.B in 1952 from Harvard Law School.

After being admitted to the Arizona State Bar in 1952, Judge Gin went into private practice and served as a Superior Court commissioner before being appointed a judge in 1975, by then Governor Raul H. Castro in 1975.

Judge Gin retired from the bench on December 31, 1994 after serving 19 years on the Superior Court in Pima County bench.
