## **COMMISSION HEARING ON FORMAL CHARGES AGAINST PINAL COUNTY JUSTICE OF THE PEACE SCOTT SULLEY**

PHOENIX. The Commission on Judicial Conduct announced today that a hearing to consider formal charges against Pinal County Justice of the Peace Scott Sulley will commence at 2:00 p.m. on Friday, August 8, 2014, in Room 230 at the Arizona Courts Building located at 1501 W. Washington Street in Phoenix, Arizona.

The hearing will be conducted before a panel of eight commission members. Court of Appeals Judge Peter Eckerstrom will preside at the hearing. Other panel members include Superior Court Judge Gus Aragon, Public Member Roger Barton, Public Member Colleen Concannon, Municipal Court Judge and Commission Chair Louis Frank Dominguez, Justice of the Peace Anna Mary Glaab, and Attorney Members Art Hinshaw and Ty Taber.

The commission is represented by Disciplinary Counsel Jennifer Perkins. Judge Sulley did not file a written response to the commission's formal charges. The hearing is open to the public. Reporters who wish to photograph, tape record, or videotape all or part of the proceedings should submit a written request for this purpose to the commission's office in advance of the hearing.
