### **Rule 12.5. Persons authorized to be present during sessions of the grand jury**

No person other than the witness under examination, counsel for the witness if the witness is a person under investigation by the grand jury, a law enforcement officer or detention officer accompanying an in-custody witness, prosecutors authorized to present evidence to the grand jury, the certified court reporter, and the interpreter, if any, shall be present during sessions of the grand jury. No person other than the grand jurors shall be present during their deliberation and voting.
