**ORDER**

On December 10, 2012, Rule 34, Rules of the Supreme Court, was amended to allow law students to take the Arizona Uniform Bar Examination in their third year of law school. The amendments to Rule 34 were adopted on an experimental basis, effective January 1, 2013, until December 31, 2015. The petitioners and the Attorney Regulation Advisory Committee were ordered to file reports with the Court on the early examination process on or before November 1, 2015. Having received and considered reports from the University of Arizona James E. Rogers College of Law and the Attorney Regulation Advisory Committee,

**IT IS ORDERED** that the amendments to Rule 34, Rules of the Supreme Court, continue in effect on an experimental basis through the February 2017 Arizona Uniform Bar Examination. The petitioners and the Attorney Regulation Advisory Committee must file supplemental reports with this Court on the early examination process by June 30, 2016.
