

**RULE 17.1, RULES OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE**

WOULD ADD LANGUAGE FROM FORMER RULE 8(b), ARIZONA RULES OF TRAFFIC AND BOATING CASES, WHICH WAS UNINTENTIONALLY ABROGATED EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2016; WOULD REINSTATE A PROCESS BY WHICH OUT-OF STATE DEFENDANTS WHO HAVE BEEN CHARGED WITH CRIMINAL TRAFFIC MISDEMEANORS OR PETTY OFFENSES MAY EASILY RESOLVE THEIR CASES

ORDERED: Petition to Modify Arizona Rules of Criminal Procedure 17.1 = ADOPTED as modified, effective October 1, 2017.

**RULES 5(a),5(b)(6),5(b)(7) et al, EVICTION ACTIONS**

WOULD REQUIRE LITIGANTS STATEWIDE TO USE COURT-APPROVED EVICTION ACTION FORMS AND AUTHORIZES THE ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTOR OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS (AOC) TO APPROVE, MODIFY, OR DELETE EVICTION ACTION FORMS AS MAY BE APPROPRIATE

ORDERED: Request to Strike March 21, 2017 "Reply" or ACAJ or in the Alternative, for Leave to File Additional Comments on Proposed Rule Revisions = DENIED.

FURTHER ORDERED: Request to Dismiss Petition = DENIED.

FURTHER ORDERED: Petition to Amend Rules 5(a), 5(b)(6), 5(b)(7) and Add Rules 13(h) and 20, of the Rules of Procedure for Eviction Actions = CONTINUED.

ORDERED: Petition to Amend Rules 8, 37, 48, 50, 52, 53, 54, 55, 56, 57, 58, 59, 60, 61, 62, 63, 63.2, 64, 65, 66, 68, 69, 76, 78, 79, 84, 85 and to Adopt New Rule 50.1 of the Arizona Rules of Procedure for the Juvenile Court = CONTINUED.

**RULE 37, CIVIL TRAFFIC & CIVIL BOATING VIOLATIONS**

WOULD AMEND THE ARIZONA TRAFFIC TICKET AND COMPLAINT (ATTC) FORM TO (1) ADD DATA FIELDS FOR A DEFENDANT'S EMAIL ADDRESS AND CELL PHONE NUMBER AND IDENTIFICATION OF A LANGUAGE PREFERENCE FOR INTERPRETATION; AND (2) NOTIFY OFFENDERS OF THE AVAILABILITY OF FINANCIAL HARDSHIP RELIEF AND THAT PROVISION OF A CELL PHONE NUMBER GRANTS PERMISSION TO RECEIVE TEXT MESSAGES FROM THE COURT

ORDERED: Petition to Amend Rule 37, Arizona Rules of Court Procedure for Civil Traffic and Civil Boating Violations = ADOPTED on an emergency basis, effective the date of the order and shall be implemented no later than January 1, 2018; will be opened for comment by separate order.
