PUBLIC COMMENT SOUGHT ON SUPERIOR COURT APPLICANTS

The public is invited to comment on 11 applicants for a vacancy on the Superior Court in Pima County created by the retirement of Judge Edgar B. Acuña.

The Pima County Commission on Trial Court Appointments will review the applications and take public testimony at a meeting on October 6, 2011 at 8:30 a.m. at the Westside Police Service Center, 1310 West Miracle Mile in Tucson, Arizona. Written comments must arrive by October 3 to be considered. Anonymous comments cannot be considered.

The commission will choose the applicants to be interviewed at the October 6 meeting. The selected applicants will be interviewed on November 7. After the interviews, the commission will recommend at least three nominees for the vacancy to Governor Jan Brewer, who will appoint the new judge.
