Public Asked for Input on Candidates For Superior Court Vacancy

The Pima County Commission on Trial Court Appointments is asking for public input on six candidates for a vacancy on the Pima County Superior Court.

The candidates are Richard B. Jones, Drue Morgan-Birch, Kathleen A. Quigley, Teresa A. Roberts, Kenneth C. Stanford and Pamela Treadwell-Rubin.

Citizens may address the commission about any of the candidates on November 7, 2011 at 8:30 a.m. at the Westside Police Service Center, 1310 West Miracle Mile in Tucson, Arizona. Public comment will not be accepted after the 8:30 a.m. hearing on November 7. Candidate interviews will follow the public hearing at 10:00 a.m. The interviews are open to the public.

Written comments about candidates can be sent to the commission at 1501 West Washington, Suite 221, Phoenix, AZ, 85007 or to jnc@courts.az.gov. They must arrive by November 1 to be considered. Anonymous comments cannot be considered.

After the interviews, the commission will recommend at least three nominees for the vacancy to Governor Jan Brewer, who will appoint the new judge.
