## **Public Asked for Input on Candidates For Superior Court Vacancy**

The Pima County Commission on Trial Court Appointments is asking for public input on eight candidates for a vacancy on the Pima County Superior Court.

The candidates are Darlene Edminson-O'Brien, Brenden J. Griffin, Lynnette C. Kimmins, Harriette P. Levitt, James E. Marner, Kathleen A. Quigley, Christopher L. Straub and Pamela Treadwell-Rubin.

Citizens may address the Commission about any of the candidates at the hearing being held on April 23<sup>rd</sup> at 8:00 a.m. at the Tucson Police Department Midtown Substation located at 1100 South Alvernon in Tucson, Arizona. Public comment will not be accepted after the 8:00 a.m. hearing. Candidate interviews will follow the public hearing at 8:00 a.m. The interviews are open to the public.

After the interviews, the Commission will recommend at least three nominees for the vacancy to Governor Jan Brewer, who will appoint the new judge.
