Governor Doug Ducey Announces Judicial Vacancy in Yuma County

PHOENIX – Governor Doug Ducey today announced he has begun accepting applications for a vacant judicial position on the Yuma County Superior Court. The vacancy was created by the retirement of Judge John N Nelson.

Applicants shall be at least thirty years and less than sixty-five years of age, of good moral character, admitted to the practice of law in Arizona, and a resident of the state for five years next prior to taking office, and a resident of Yuma County for at least one year prior to taking office.
