The Commission on Appellate Court Appointments will review the applications and hear comments at a public meeting on August 4. The meeting will be held in room 345 of the Arizona State Courts Building, 1501 West Washington, starting at 9:30 a.m. Citizens may address the commission at that time or send written comments to 1501 W. At the August 4 meeting, the commission will decide which applicants will be interviewed for the opening. The selected applicants will be interviewed on August 26. After the interviews the commission will recommend at least three nominees for the opening to Governor Doug Ducey, who will appoint the new judge.
