## **eFiling Now Available in Yavapai County**

PHOENIX - The Arizona Supreme Court is pleased to announce that Yavapai County Superior Court is now accepting electronic filings of civil case initiation and civil subsequent documents (CV & CP cases) through the eFile.AZCourts.gov e-filing application. eFile.AZCourts.gov includes the ability to attach more than one lead document per submission, issue summons and subpoenas, generate the civil cover sheet, and other functionality.

Many of you may already be using AZTurboCourt to file your documents in the Arizona Supreme Court, Court of Appeals Division One, and the Superior Court in Pima and Maricopa Counties; AZTurboCourt continues to be an operating and approved e-filing and e-service provider in the State of Arizona and is expected to be available in Yavapai County in the near future.
