PUBLIC COMMENT SOUGHT ON SUPERIOR COURT APPLICANTS

The public is invited to comment on 13 applicants for two vacancies on the Superior Court in Pima County created by the retirement of Judges Hector E. Campoy and Michael J. Cruikshank.

The applicants are John E. Aboud, Jeffrey T. Bergin, Richard B. Jones, Harriette P. Levitt, Nanette C.A. Morrow, Lori A. Petersen, Kathleen A. Quigley, Antonio F. Riojas, Jr., Teresa A. Roberts, Kenneth C. Stanford, Pamela A. Treadwell-Rubin, Catherine M. Woods and Angela W. Woolridge.

The Pima County Commission on Trial Court Appointments will review the applications and take public testimony at a meeting on June 27, 2011. The meeting location is to be announced. Written comments must arrive by June 23 to be considered. Anonymous comments cannot be considered.

The commission will choose the applicants to be interviewed at the June 27 meeting. The selected applicants will be interviewed on July 25. After the interviews, the commission will recommend at least three nominees for each vacancy to Governor Jan Brewer, who will appoint the new judges.
