Public Asked for Input on Candidates For Superior Court Vacancies

The Pima County Commission on Trial Court Appointments is asking for public input on six candidates for two vacancies on the Pima County Superior Court.

The candidates are Jeffrey T. Bergin, Richard B. Jones, Lori A. Petersen, Kenneth C. Stanford, Pamela Treadwell-Rubin and Catherine M. Woods.

Citizens may address the commission about any of the candidates on July 25, 2011 at 8:30 a.m. at the Westside Police Service Center, 1310 West Miracle Mile in Tucson, Arizona. Public comment will not be accepted after the 8:30 a.m. hearing on July 25. Candidate interviews will follow the public hearing at 9:30 a.m. The interviews are open to the public.

Written comments about candidates can be sent to the commission at 1501 West Washington, Suite 221, Phoenix, AZ, 85007 or to jnc@courts.az.gov. They must arrive by July 20 to be considered. Anonymous comments cannot be considered.

After the interviews, the commission will recommend at least three nominees for each vacancy to Governor Jan Brewer, who will appoint the new judges.
