Public Asked for Input on Candidates For Superior Court Vacancy

The Pima County Commission on Trial Court Appointments is asking for public input on five candidates for a vacancy on the Pima County Superior Court.

The candidates are Jeffrey T. Bergin, Danelle B. Liwski, Kenneth C. Stanford, Pamela Treadwell-Rubin and Catherine M. Woods.

Citizens may address the commission about any of the candidates on March 21, 2011 at 8:30 a.m. at the Mid-Town Police Service Station, 1100 South Alvernon Way in Tucson, Arizona. Public comment will not be accepted after the 8:30 a.m. hearing on March 21. Candidate interviews will follow the public hearing at 9:30 a.m. The interviews are open to the public.

Written comments about candidates can be sent to the commission at 1501 West Washington, Suite 221, Phoenix, AZ, 85007 or to jnc@courts.az.gov. They must arrive by March 17 to be considered. Anonymous comments cannot be considered.

After the interviews, the commission will recommend at least three nominees for the vacancy to Governor Jan Brewer, who will appoint the new judge.
