Citizens may address the commission about any of the candidates on August 11, 2011, at 8:00 a.m. at the Arizona State Courts Building, 1501 W. Washington Street, Conference Room 345. Public comment will not be accepted after the 8:00 a.m. hearing on August 11. Candidate interviews will follow the public hearing and continue on August 12. The interviews are open to the public.

Written comments about candidates can be sent to the commission at 1501 W. Washington, Suite 221, Phoenix, AZ, 85007 or to jnc@courts.az.gov. They must arrive by August 5 to be considered. Anonymous comments cannot be considered.

After the interviews, the commission will recommend at least three nominees for each opening to Governor Jan Brewer, who will appoint the new judges.
