

ORDERED: Request to Amend Rule Petition to Include a Rule 59 Amendment for Transcripts in Rule 58 Appeals = ADOPTED as modified, effective January 1, 2017.

WOULD HARMONIZE THE OATH WITH THE ARIZONA LOYALTY OATH OF OFFICE AND RULE 32(c)(3), RULES OF THE SUPREME COURT, AND WOULD EMPHASIZE ADDITIONAL AREAS IN THE CREED BASED ON PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE SINCE THE CREED WAS ORIGINALLY ADOPTED; WOULD ALSO HARMONIZE RULE 41 WITH OATH AND CREED

ORDERED: Petition to Amend The Oath of Admission to the Bar and Lawyer's Creed of Professionalism = ADOPTED as modified, effective January 1, 2017.

### **RULE 17.1, RULES OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE**

WOULD ADD LANGUAGE FROM FORMER RULE 8(B), ARIZONA RULES OF TRAFFIC AND BOATING CASES, WHICH WAS UNINTENTIONALLY ABROGATED EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2016; WOULD REINSTATE A PROCESS BY WHICH OUT-OF STATE DEFENDANTS WHO HAVE BEEN CHARGED WITH CRIMINAL TRAFFIC MISDEMEANORS OR PETTY OFFENSES MAY EASILY RESOLVE THEIR CASES

ORDERED: Petition to Modify Arizona Rules of Criminal Procedure 17.1 = CONTINUED.

### **RULE 72, RULES OF FAMILY LAW PROCEDURE**

WOULD (1) PRECLUDE THE TRIAL COURT FROM APPOINTING A FAMILY LAW MASTER ON ITS OWN MOTION WITHOUT THE AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES ; (2) CLARIFY THAT THE COURT MAY NOT APPOINT A FAMILY LAW MASTER TO SERVE AS A PARENTING COORDINATOR; AND (3) CLARIFY THAT THE COURT MAY NOT DELEGATE TO A FAMILY LAW MASTER THE COURT'S JUDICIAL AUTHORITY TO MAKE DECISIONS CONCERNING LEGAL DECISION MAKING OR PARENTING TIME

ORDERED: Petition to Amend Rule 72 of the Arizona Rules of Family Law Procedure = ADOPTED as modified, effective January 1, 2017.

WOULD REQUIRE LITIGANTS STATEWIDE TO USE COURT-APPROVED EVICTION ACTION FORMS AND AUTHORIZES THE ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTOR OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS (AOC) TO APPROVE, MODIFY, OR DELETE EVICTION ACTION FORMS AS MAY BE APPROPRIATE

ORDERED: Petition to Amend Rules 5(a), 5(b)(6), 5(b)(7) and Add Rules 13(h) and 20, of the Rules of Procedure for Eviction Actions = CONTINUED for an additional comment period until February 17, 2017, on the attached forms which were proposed in Petitioner's reply.
