The Court having considered the Petition for Review in this matter,

IT IS ORDERED granting review.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED remanding this matter to the trial court for appointment of counsel and further proceedings in accordance with Rule 32.4(c)(2), Arizona Rules of Criminal Procedure. Because Petitioner's June 2012 post-conviction relief notice and petition, taken together, constituted substantial compliance, he is entitled to an opportunity to show that his diagnosis of post-traumatic stress disorder constitutes a colorable claim of newly discovered evidence that might have altered his sentence. See *State v. Bilke*, 162 Ariz. 51, 781 P.2d 28 (1989).
