O R D E R

Upon consideration of Applicant Jennifer Lynn Perez's *Petition for Review* and the Committee on Character and Fitness's *Response to Petition for Review*,

IT IS ORDERED the Petition for Review is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the five-year time requirement of Rule 34(m), Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court, is waived. Applicant is permitted to reapply for admission one year from the date of this order. Applicant should be prepared to meet her burden to show by clear and convincing evidence that she has the requisite character and fitness to practice law. Applicant may present letters, witnesses and pertinent documents. She should address Other Relevant Conduct under the Arizona Rules of the Supreme Court Rule 36(b)(3) including (C) regarding assertions in her verified petition for review that she attended a hearing on the change of venue motion in Oregon in 2009, and (G) regarding neglect of financial responsibilities, specifically

concerning the 2011 bankruptcy. She may also wish to address the factors in Rule 36(b)(4) for the Committee's consideration.
