O R D E R

Applicant NASSER USAMA ABUJBARAH has established to the satisfaction of the Hearing Panel and this Court that his application for reinstatement should be granted. Pursuant to Rule 65 of the Rules of the Supreme Court,

**IT IS ORDERED** that NASSER USAMA ABUJBARAH is reinstated as an active member of the State Bar of Arizona as of the date of this order.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that upon the effective date of reinstatement NASSER USAMA ABUJBARAH shall be placed on probation for a period of two years, under the terms and conditions as listed below:

1. Within ten days of reinstatement, Applicant must contact the Compliance Monitor at the State Bar of Arizona and schedule a Member Assistance Program (MAP) assessment and enter into a MAP contract with terms and conditions to include random drug and alcohol testing. Applicant must comply with all the

terms and conditions of the MAP contract, which shall be incorporated herein by reference. Applicant will be responsible for any costs associated with MAP.

2. Within ten days of reinstatement, Applicant must contact the Compliance Monitor at the State Bar of Arizona and schedule a Law Office Management Assistance Program (LOMAP) assessment and enter into a LOMAP contract. Applicant has agreed that if he chooses to resume practicing bankruptcy law he must first complete twenty (20) hours of CLE relevant to this practice area and his practice will be limited to Chapter 7 representation during his first year of reinstatement. Applicant must comply with all the terms and conditions of the LOMAP contract, which shall be incorporated herein by reference. Applicant will be responsible for any costs associated with LOMAP.
3. Within ten days of reinstatement, Applicant will contact the Compliance monitor at the State Bar of Arizona and schedule attendance at the next available Trust Account Ethics Enhancement Program (TAEEP). Applicant will be responsible for the cost of attending the program.

The State Bar shall report material violations of the terms of probation pursuant to Rule 60(a)(5)(C). A hearing may be held within thirty days to determine if the terms of probation have been violated

and if any additional conditions should be imposed. The burden of proof shall be on the State Bar to prove non-compliance by a preponderance of the evidence.
