O R D E R

Applicant DANIEL P. KRAMER has established to the satisfaction of the Hearing Panel and this Court that his application for reinstatement should be granted. Pursuant to Rule 65 of the Rules of the Supreme Court,

IT IS ORDERED that DANIEL P. KRAMER is reinstated as an active member of the State Bar of Arizona effective the date of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon the effective date of reinstatement DANIEL P. KRAMER shall be placed on probation for a period of two years, under the terms and conditions as listed below:

1. Within thirty days of reinstatement, Applicant shall contact the State Bar's Compliance Monitor to enter into a Member Assistance Program (MAP) contract. As part of the MAP contract, Applicant shall do the following:

- a) Abstain from alcohol and other drug use, unless prescribed to him for health reasons;
- b) Undergo random drug/alcohol testing twice a month for one year and then once a month for one year;
- c) Continue attending at least one 12-step meeting a week for two years;
- d) Obtain a peer monitor and have monthly contact;
- e) Undergo psychological counseling/support from a licensed professional with expertise treating behavioral health disorder and substance use disorder twice a month for two months and then at least once a month for ten months.

Applicant shall comply with all the terms of the MAP contract which shall be incorporated herein by reference. Applicant shall be responsible for any costs associated with MAP.

2. If Applicant should return to private practice, within thirty days Applicant shall contact the Compliance Monitor at the State Bar and submit to a Law Office Management Program (LOMAP) assessment. Applicant shall enter into a LOMAP contract based on the recommendations following the assessment. The contract shall include a requirement that Applicant complete the State Bar's Trust Account Ethics Enhancement Program. Applicant shall notify LOMAP of any change in his work situation and shall submit to reassessment, as necessary. Applicant shall be responsible for any costs associate with LOMAP.

3. The State Bar shall report material violations of the terms of probation pursuant to Rule 60(a)(5)(C), Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., and a hearing may be held within thirty days to determine if the terms of probation have been violated and if an additional sanction should be imposed. The burden of proof shall be on the State Bar to prove non-compliance by a preponderance of the evidence.
