Applicant Adaikala Mary Kennedy filed an "Expedited Petition for Review and Waiver of Strict Compliance for the Rules of Admission to the Arizona State Bar." Applicant seeks a waiver of the requirement that she graduate with a juris doctor degree from an ABA-accredited law school or graduate with a juris doctor degree and practice in another state for five of the past seven years.
