O R D E R

This matter having come before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of Arizona, it having duly rendered its decision and no petition for review having been filed,

IT IS ORDERED granting sua sponte review to modify the terms of probation. One of the terms of probation in the parties' agreement for discipline required respondent to undergo a "Fitness to Practice Independent Medical Evaluation" and be found fit to practice before returning to active status. The Court finds that the requirement of a positive "Fitness to Practice Independent Medical Evaluation" should be imposed as a condition of reinstatement rather than as a term of probation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that respondent and the State Bar shall notify the Court of their consent to this modification by 5 p.m. on August 2, 2011. If both parties do not agree to the modification or if the Court does not receive the required notice of consent, the agreement for discipline by consent will be rejected and the matter

remanded to the Disciplinary Clerk for further proceedings before the  
Presiding Disciplinary Judge.
