Applicant TROY P. FOSTER has established to the satisfaction of the Hearing Panel and this Court that his application for reinstatement should be granted. Pursuant to Rule 65 of the Rules of the Supreme Court,

IT IS ORDERED that TROY P. FOSTER is reinstated as an active member of the State Bar of Arizona effective the date of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that TROY P. FOSTER shall comply with any and all orders of the United States Bankruptcy Court with respect to the adversary proceeding concerning the restitution to Ford & Harrison.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon the effective date of reinstatement TROY P. FOSTER shall be placed on probation for a period of two years, under the terms and conditions as listed below:

1. Within thirty days of reinstatement, Applicant shall contact the State Bar's Member Assistance Program (MAP) and submit to an assessment. Applicant shall thereafter enter into a MAP contract based on the recommendations made by the MAP director or designee. Applicant shall comply with all the terms of the MAP contract which shall be incorporated herein by reference. Applicant shall be responsible for any costs associated with MAP.

2. The State Bar shall report material violations of the terms of probation pursuant to Rule 60(a)(5), Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., and a hearing may be held within thirty days to determine if the terms of probation have been violated and if an additional sanction should be imposed. The burden of proof shall be on the State Bar to prove noncompliance by a preponderance of the evidence.
