**O R D E R**

Applicant MATTHEW CHRISTOPHER LARGENT has filed an application for reinstatement. The hearing panel has recommended that his application be granted, based in part upon an earlier ruling that Mr. Largent met the criteria stated in Rule 64(f)(1)(B) of the Rules of the Supreme Court "as an active member of the Washington Bar for not less than fourteen months." To proceed under certain exceptions to formal reinstatement that are provided in that rule, an applicant must submit proof of active practice in another jurisdiction during the entirety of a resignation period. Fourteen months is not the entirety of Mr. Largent's resignation period. Under these circumstances, Rule 65 of the Rules of the Supreme Court applies.

MATTHEW CHRISTOPHER LARGENT has established to the satisfaction of this Court that he is qualified for reinstatement to active bar membership. Therefore, pursuant to Rule 65,

**IT IS ORDERED** that MATTHEW CHRISTOPHER LARGENT is reinstated as an active member of the State Bar of Arizona effective the date of this order.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that additional requirements for reinstatement, contained in Rule 64(c) of the Rules of the Supreme Court, are WAIVED.
