Applicant Beatrice Lezongiya Nwinee Deezua filed a verified "Petition to Waive the ABA Requirement" seeking a waiver of the requirement that she graduate with a juris doctor from an ABA-accredited law school or graduate with a juris doctor and practice in another state for five of the past seven years.
