**O R D E R**

Applicant Shufan Sung filed a Petition for Review from the Committee on Character and Fitness' denial of her application to sit for the Arizona Uniform Bar Examination. Applicant seeks a waiver of the requirement that she graduate with a juris doctor degree from an ABA-accredited law school or graduate with a juris doctor degree and practice in another state for five of the past seven years. Ariz. R. Sup. Ct. 34(b)(1)(D). Applicant also filed a motion to seal documents in Appendix IV and Appendix VI that contain private information. The Committee on Character and Fitness filed a response. Upon consideration,

**IT IS ORDERED** that the Applicant's petition for review is denied without prejudice to her reapplying for waiver if she submits more information about her legal practice experience and how her legal education is the equivalent to graduating from an ABA-accredited law school.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** granting the motion to seal Appendix IV  
and Appendix VI.
