The State Bar filed a Motion for Interim Suspension with the presiding disciplinary judge pursuant to Rule 61(c)(2), Rules of the Supreme Court. Respondent CHAD JAMES WHITE filed a response. On November 14, 2011, the presiding disciplinary judge issued an order imposing temporary suspension and recommending that this Court issue an order of interim suspension. The order and report was filed in this Court pursuant to Rule 61(c)(2)(D).

IT IS ORDERED that the Motion for Interim Suspension is continued.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the matter is remanded to the presiding disciplinary judge for an evidentiary hearing pursuant to Rule 61(c)(2)(D) to determine whether the imposition of additional conditions of supervision would be sufficient to protect the public and, therefore, obviate the need for an interim suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the presiding disciplinary

judge's order of temporary suspension will remain in effect pending the outcome of the hearing and subsequent recommendation to this Court.
