O R D E R

Applicant **CINDRA L. WHITE** has not established to the satisfaction of this Court or the Hearing Panel that she is qualified for reinstatement to active bar membership. The Rules of the Supreme Court provide for formal reinstatement only to the active practice of law upon the satisfaction of the requirements of Rule 65 to prove fitness to practice and competence, among other things. A stipulation between parties may not change the requirements for reinstatement established by the Court. Therefore, pursuant to the Rules of the Supreme Court,

IT IS ORDERED that the application for reinstatement of **CINDRA L. WHITE** is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the prohibition contained in Rule 65 (a)(4) is hereby suspended.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **CINDRA L. WHITE** may, within one year from the effective the date of this Order, supplement her application for reinstatement to demonstrate proof of her fitness to practice law and competence as required by Rule 65, including completion of continuing legal education requirements.
