DIRECTIVE

Pursuant to A.R.S. §14-5651 and Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2002-102 and as further provided in the Administrative Rules governing fiduciaries in Arizona, specifically Rule 1.2.2, "The Director upon the Director's own initiative or upon receiving a complaint may conduct such investigation as the Director deems proper to determine whether a person has violated these rules...". The Director of the Administrative Office of the Courts ("AOC") makes the following findings of fact and order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Director of Administrative Office of the Courts finds as follows:

1. Mildred Ellis, ("Ellis") was the principal of Guardianships of Southern Arizona Inc., ("GSA") from July 22, 2002 through the revocation of GSA's certificate number 20211. Due to the findings of the investigation and subsequent revocation of GSA's certification, the Director deems it appropriate to conduct an investigation into the practices of Ellis during her employment as principal of GSA to determine whether Ellis as principal and a certified fiduciary, has violated any statutes, rules or codes relevant to the fiduciary program.

ORDER OF THE DIRECTOR

IT IS ORDERED an investigation shall commence regarding the activities of Ellis as principal of GSA or any other activities as a certified fiduciary.
