Arizona Code of Judicial Administration § 7-205(D)(1) authorizes the administrative director to establish policies, procedures and forms necessary to administer the Defensive Driving Program. In accordance with § 7-205, the administrative director signed Administrative Directive No. 2001-01, effective December 21, 2001, adopting policies for certification and administration of alternative delivery formats for defensive driving classes in the Defensive Driving Program.

An amendment to the above captioned policies as adopted by Administrative Directive No. 2001-01 having come before the Arizona Judicial Council on June 21, 2004 and having been approved and recommended for adoption,

Now, therefore, pursuant to § 7-205(D)(1),

IT IS DIRECTED that the above captioned revised policies, attached hereto, governing the specific requirements related to the certification and operation of alternative delivery methods as defined in § 7-205, be adopted and are applicable to alternative delivery schools and formats for the Defensive Driving Program.

IT IS FURTHER DIRECTED these policies are effective on and after the date of signature.
