Courts that have adopted the Procurement Rules for the Judicial Branch are responsible for establishing an administrative process for resolving bid protests, contract claims, and debarments. A standardized process is needed by which parties can seek judicial review of the final decision in these administrative matters.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution and pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-2501(E),

IT IS ORDERED that judicial review of a final decision issued under a court's administrative process for resolving bid protests, contract claims, and debarments resulting from use of the Procurement Rules for the Judicial Branch shall be by special action filed within 35 days after entry of the final decision, pursuant to the Arizona Rules of Procedure for Special Actions.
