In accordance with the Arizona Code of Judicial Administration, § 1-104, the Chief Justice may establish standing committees to the Arizona Judicial Council to assist the Council in carrying out its responsibilities.

Under the authority granted to the Chief Justice by the Arizona Constitution, Article VI, Section 3, the Arizona Judicial Branch 2014 Achievement Awards Selection Committee is established. Therefore, after due consideration,

IT IS ORDERED that the Arizona Judicial Branch Achievement Awards for 2014 shall be presented to individuals, groups, or courts who have made substantial contributions to the following categories: Promoting Access to Justice; Protecting Children, Families, and Communities; Improving Processes to Better Serve the Public; Enhancing Professionalism within Arizona's Courts; and Improving Communications and Community Participation. The awards shall be presented at the Annual Court Leadership Conference.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the following individuals are appointed to the Arizona Judicial Branch 2014 Achievement Awards Selection Committee for the express purpose of considering Achievement Awards 2014 nominations. Committee members shall serve at the pleasure of the Chief Justice. The appointed members shall make award recommendations to the Arizona Supreme Court and shall hold their appointed position beginning on August 1, 2014 and expiring on October 31, 2014.
