Pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution, the Supreme Court exercises administrative authority over all courts of the state through the Administrative Office of the Courts.

Pursuant to the foregoing authority, the Supreme Court issued Administrative Order No. 2014-46, placing administrative authority for the South Tucson Municipal Court with the Honorable Sarah Simmons, Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Pima County. The Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Pima County has recently confirmed that her continued administrative oversight of this court is no longer warranted.
