Due to concern for the spread of COVID-19 in the general population, the Governor of the State of Arizona declared a statewide emergency pursuant to A.R.S. § 26-303 and in accordance with A.R.S. § 26-301(15). Cooperation by the judicial branch of government is essential to reducing the risks to the public associated with this health emergency.

Arizona courts remain open to serve the public. Nevertheless, given the current emergency, and in the interest of public safety, certain limitations and changes in court practices relating to review of superior court commissioner performance are necessary.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Sections 3 and 5, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that for the 2020 judicial review cycle, the term of service for a Judicial Performance Review conference team member under Rule 4(c) of the Rules of Procedure for Judicial Performance Review is hereby extended to January 31, 2021.
