Due to concern for the spread of COVID-19 in the general population, the Governor of the State of Arizona declared a statewide public health emergency on March 11, 2020 pursuant to A.R.S. § 26-303 and in accordance with A.R.S. § 26-301(15).

During this public health emergency, Court Security Officer Trainings have been postponed and reduced in size. Court Security Officers are not able to receive or complete the required training in the timeframes set forth in Administrative Order Nos. 2020-04 and 2020-06.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that all court-employed security officers who were hired prior to September 11, 2019 are required to complete the court security officer certification requirements by June 30, 2021.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all court-employed security officers who are authorized by their local court to be armed shall complete the firearms training program required by ACJA § 5-306 no later than June 30, 2021.
