Fiduciary licensing fees have not been increased since 1999 for individuals and since 2002 for businesses resulting in non-licensing fee revenue being used to supplement the cost of operating the fiduciary regulatory program. The revenue sources used to supplement the cost of operating fiduciary regulatory program have been declining for the last five years.

An amendment to the above-captioned section of the Arizona Code of Judicial Administration came before the Arizona Judicial Council on March 19, 2020 and was approved and recommended for adoption.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution, and A.R.S. § 14-5651,

IT IS ORDERED that the amendments to ACJA § 7-202 as indicated on the attached document are adopted effective April 1, 2020. All other provisions of § 7-202 remain unchanged and in effect.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that after the effective date of this Order, individuals and businesses seeking to renew their fiduciary license during the 2020 calendar year shall pay a \$400 renewal fee in the following manner: \$200 which shall accompany their renewal application which must be submitted on or before May 31, 2020; and \$200 on or before May 31, 2021. Failure to timely pay the second payment on or before May 31, 2021 is grounds for revocation of the fiduciary license.
