PRO TEMPORE ORDER

The presiding judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in Santa Cruz County has requested the appointment of a law-trained, full-time justice of the peace to serve as a judge pro tempore in Santa Cruz County for the purpose of enhancing the court's ability to process cases. Therefore, pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-141,

IT IS ORDERED that the Honorable Mary Helen Maley, State Bar #011666, is appointed judge pro tempore to serve the Superior Court in Santa Cruz County for a term beginning July 1, 2011 and ending June 30, 2012, in accordance with A.R.S. §§ 12-141 et. seq., and will serve as assigned by the presiding judge.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this appointment is conditioned upon the approval of the Santa Cruz County Board of Supervisors pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-141, and upon the agreement by the appointee to serve for no compensation or benefits, fiscal or otherwise, as provided in A.R.S. § 12-142(C) and A.R.S. § 12-143.
