PRO TEMPORE ORDER

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this appointment is conditioned upon the approval of the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-141, and upon the agreement by the appointee to serve for no compensation or benefits, fiscal or otherwise, as provided in A.R.S. § 12-142(C) and A.R.S. § 12-143 for service as a judge pro tempore.
