This matter came before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of Arizona on November 16, 2002, pursuant to Rule 56(a), Ariz. R. S. Ct., for consideration of the Tender of Admissions and Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Agreement) and Joint Memorandum in support of Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Joint Memorandum), filed October 9, 2002, providing for a censure, one (1) year of probation with the Law Office Management Assistance Program (LOMAP) and the Trust Account Ethics Enhancement Program (TAEPP), and costs of these disciplinary proceedings.

Decision

The nine members of the Commission unanimously recommend accepting and incorporating by reference the Agreement and Joint Memorandum¹ providing for a censure, one (1) year of probation (LOMAP & TAEPP), and costs of these disciplinary proceedings. The terms of probation are as follows:
