This matter came before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of Arizona on July 12, 2003, pursuant to Rule 56(a), Ariz. R. S. Ct., for consideration of the Tender of Admissions and Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Agreement) and Joint Memorandum in Support of Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Joint Memorandum), filed May 30, 2003, providing for a four month suspension, two years of probation, subject to early release, the terms consistent with the terms of his criminal probation, and costs of these disciplinary proceedings.

Decision

The nine¹ members of the Commission unanimously recommend accepting and incorporating by reference the Agreement and Joint Memorandum² providing for a four month suspension, two years of probation, subject to early release, the terms consistent with the terms of his criminal probation, and costs.

¹ Commissioner Bowman did not participate in these proceedings. Larry W. Suciu, a Hearing Officer from Yuma participated as an ad hoc member.

² The Commission notes that the standard compliance language contained in the Agreement inadvertently states that a hearing will be conducted "in no event less than thirty (30) days" and should read "in no event later than thirty (30) days." See Agreement, p.4 item 4.
