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This matter came before the Disciplinary Commission of the Supreme Court of Arizona on November 8, 2003, pursuant to Rule 56(a), Ariz. R. S. Ct., for consideration of the Tender of Admissions and Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Agreement) and Joint Memorandum in Support of Agreement for Discipline by Consent (Joint Memorandum) filed August 22, 2003, providing for a two-year suspension, retroactive to May 8, 2003, two years of probation upon reinstatement with the terms to be determined at that time, binding fee arbitration, and costs of these disciplinary proceedings. Respondent's counsel and counsel for the State Bar were present.


Decision

The nine¹ members of the Commission unanimously recommend accepting and incorporating by reference the Agreement and Joint Memorandum providing for a two-year suspension, retroactive to May 8, 2003, two years of probation upon reinstatement with


